

Offshore Sail Repair Kit

Items(s)	Use(s)
1 Pair 8" Shears	Cutting sail cloth and leather
1 Medium Weight Palm	All hand sewing needs (specify right or left)
1 Bench Hook	Sailmaker's third hand
1 Pack 10 Hand Needles	Assorted needles for hand sewing
1 Lb. Hand Sewing Thread	For hand sewing
Machine Sewing Thread (2) 2oz. Spools	For machine sewing
5 yds. ½" Tubular Webbing	For seizing slides
5 yds. 1½" Flat Webbing	For reinforcing "strainers" in corner rings
2 #10 SS Rings	For replacing torn out corner
6 #4 Brass Rings	For hand-sewn replacement of torn out ⅜" - ½" grommet (e.g. luff or foot grommet)
25 Push Pins	For pinning sail flat to prepare for adding a patch
1 Roll Double Stick Tape	For holding patch in place for sewing
2 Seam Rippers	For removing stitches to replace worn or torn fabric (e.g. batten pockets)
1 Roll White "Repair" Tape	For temporary spinnaker repair
25 ft. 6" Sticky Dacron	For temporary Dacron repair (stitch around to make permanent)
5 yds. Dacron Slit Tape	For repairing heavy sails (5" 8oz.)
1 Leech Line Tri-Cleat	For tensioning leech and foot lines
1 Square Foot Leather	Chafe protection
Canvas Ditty Bag	Holds repair kit contents
